

Bloodborne Pathogens



Days: 2 hours

Prerequisites: There is no skills test or demonstration required for completion of this course. There is an optional written exam if the employer requires an exam for completion.

Audience: The Heartsaver Bloodborne Pathogens course is designed specifically for workers with a reasonable chance of coming into contact with bloodborne pathogens such as correctional officers, childcare workers, security guards, maintenance workers, school personnel, hotel housekeepers, health and fitness club staff and tattoo artists.

Description: Heartsaver Bloodborne Pathogens online course teaches students how to protect themselves and others from being exposed to blood or blood-containing materials. This course is designed to meet OSHA requirements for bloodborne pathogens training when paired with site-specific instruction. Upon completion of the online course, students receive a course completion certificate that can be presented to their employer. There are no skills test or skills demonstration at the end of this course; however, the AHA provides an optional written exam if the employer requires an exam for completion.

Course Objectives: This course uses the PACT acronym (Protect, Act, Clean, Tell) and tagline, "Make a PACT, Know How to Act™," to help students learn and easily recall bloodborne pathogens training.

Students learn how to:

- ☐ Protect themselves from blood or blood-containing materials.
- ☐ Act quickly and safely.
- ☐ Clean the area that has blood or blood-containing materials.
- ☐ Tell their supervisor about the incident.
